Commitment to achieving Net Zero

Performance Networks are committed to achieving Net Zero by 2040 at the latest.

There are no existing carbon emission reduction targets on which to report any progress currently.

To progress towards Net Zero, we have initially set carbon reduction targets to reduce emissions from our baseline by to 50% to be reached no later than 2030. During this time, we will set our targets for the remaining period to ensure we reach Net Zero by 2040.
